

Purpose of Policy:	The policy identifies the Colegio's terms and conditions in providing scholarship opportunities for former athletes.
Detailed Policy Statement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Former athletes or those students, who used to be recipients of the Colegio's Athletic Scholarship Program, can re-avail of the Colegio's scholarship grant upon fulfilling the succeeding terms and conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Qualified athletes should have represented the Colegio in the National Collegiate Athletic Association for two seasons. 2. Has not been subjected to any disciplinary action 3. Has not been removed or withdrawn from the team's official roster of athletes as a result of poor academic performance and disciplinary issues 4. Has not been permanently removed from the team's official roster of athletes as a result of poor performance • Former athletes, who wish to finish their studies under the Colegio's scholarship programs, should submit the following documents to the Athletics Moderator: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Letter of Intention addressed to the Vice President for Financial Affairs 2. Certification of Grades and summary of subject deficiencies, which can be obtained from the Office of the Registrar • The application is subject for endorsement of the Athletics Moderator and recommendation of the Director of the Office of Student Affairs. • The amount of discount and other terms of scholarship is subject for approval of the Vice President for Financial Affairs. • The Vice President for Financial Affairs allows a maximum of two academic years for a former athlete to complete his / her studies, under this extended scholarship. • Recipients shall enter into a memorandum of agreement with the Colegio, where the terms and conditions shall be observed by the grantees during the extended scholarship. • The Office of the Athletics Moderator is responsible in monitoring the academic performance of the former athletes. • Recipients are required to pass all enrolled subjects and are not allowed to make any unauthorized withdrawal (UW). Otherwise, they will be required to pay the equivalent cost of each subject failed or withdrawn. The said amount shall be determined by the Office of the Vice President for Financial Affairs. • Recipients, subjected to any form of disciplinary action in the course of the extended scholarship, shall pay the tuition, miscellaneous and other costs related to the scholarship.
